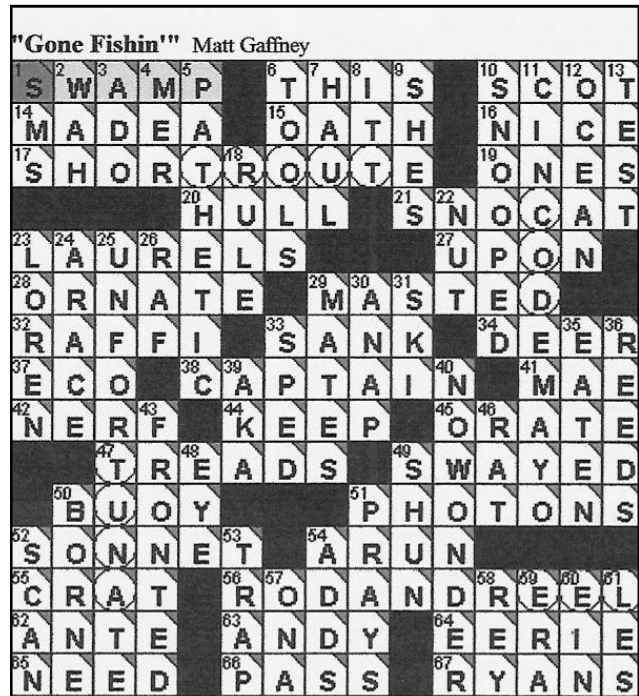

From the Galley...

Corn & Black Bean Salsa

Donna (Tidal39 II)

- 1 bag (2 cups) frozen corn kernels
- 1 can black beans rinse & drain
- 2 plum tomatoes-diced
- 1/2 cup Red onion-diced
- 1 Red pepper-diced
- 1 jalapeño-seeded and diced
- 1/2 cup fresh cilantro finely chopped
- Juice from 1 lime
- 2 tbsp canola oil
- 1/8 tsp ground red pepper

- * Defrost corn, add all ingredients and mix well.
- * Serve with Corn Chips.
- * Can be made ahead.
- * Keeps well in fridge for 5-6 days.

You can make soup with the leftovers.
Add chicken broth and diced white meat chicken.

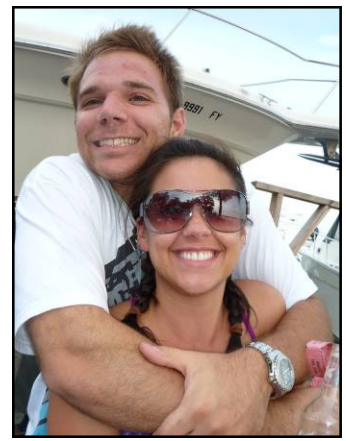

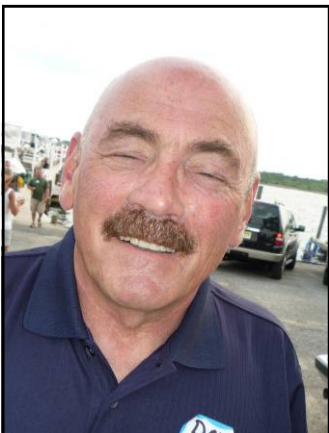

KEEP OUR WATERS SAFE AND SECURE.

Safe boating is important to every boater. Help the Coast Guard and other security forces do their job.

- Remind the boat operator they are **NOT** to approach within 100 yards of any U.S. Naval Vessel. **IT'S THE LAW.** Also keep your distance from cruise liners and other commercial ships.
- Do not stop or anchor under bridges or in channels.
- Look for anything "out of the ordinary." Ask the boat operator to report what you see to security forces.
- **Wear your life jacket and be a safe boater.** This helps keep security forces ready to respond to other needs.

Megan is safe and secure since she's wearing her life jacket. She's helping to keep our waters safe and secure by watching for anything "out of the ordinary."

Start out with your life jacket and go through the maze. Stay away from the naval vessel, security zone and bridge to get to the binoculars. These will help you see any threats to our waters.

so please support the fund.



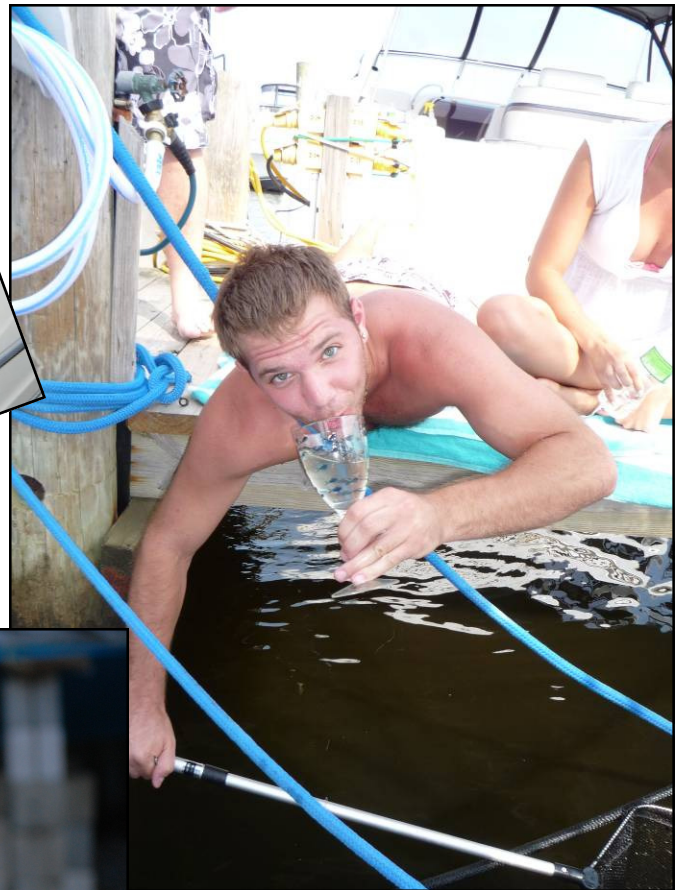

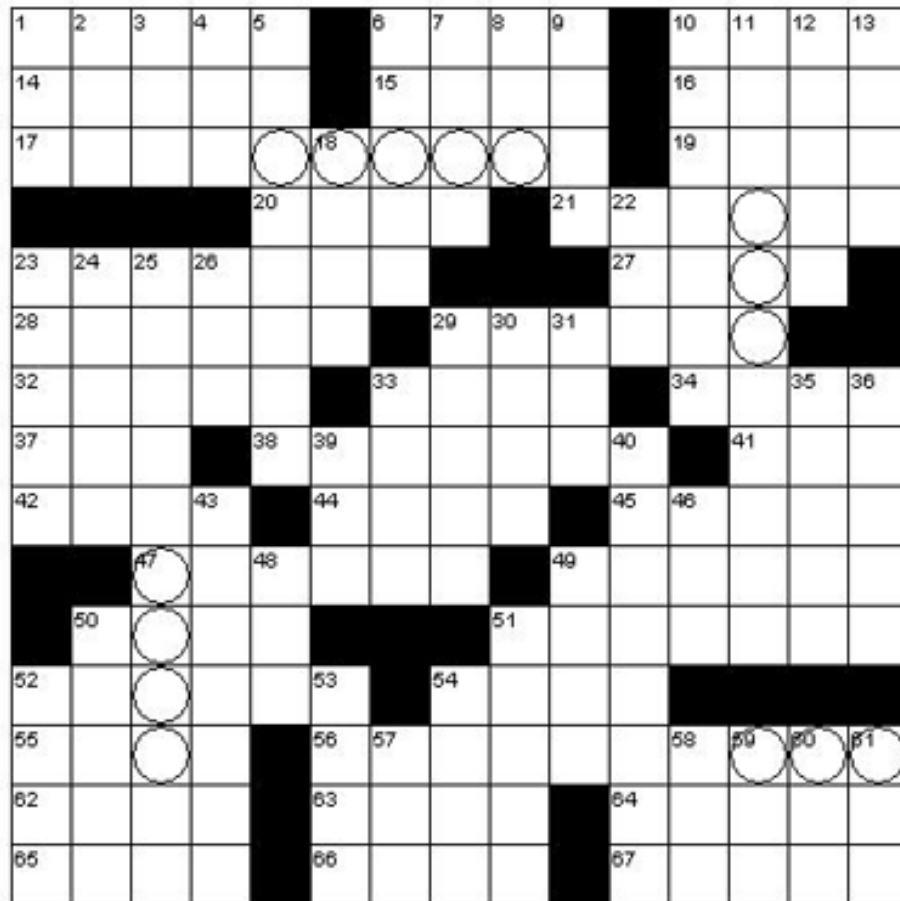
